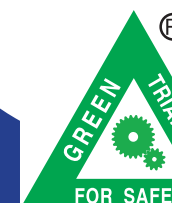

## NSCI Certified Internal SHE Auditor Course 8 - 10 July 2026, National Safety Council, Hq., Navi Mumbai

### ABOUT THE COURSE

Safety and Health audit is a management tool for systematic evaluation of how well the operation and maintenance procedures match with design intent and statutes. There are already large tome of Health and Safety legislation continues to grow with the introduction of additional regulations and guidelines. Moreover, Governments also use a larger stick to punish non-compliance. Not only bigger fines are imposed on companies but their directors and senior management face imprisonment for neglect of duties.

Also, the adverse public relations resulting from poor regulatory compliance can result in lost consumer goodwill and it can have a negative impact on valuable brand names. Statutory Compliance Audits can be used as a useful tool in reviewing an organization's health and safety procedures and legal compliance. Findings from the compliance audit identify gaps in an organization's current policy and procedure to enhance its safety performance. NSC has designed this 3-day training course as a regulatory audit provides an objective review of facility operations and company practices and provides a recommended process to ensure that compliance continues.

### LEARNING OUTCOME

After completion of this course the participants will be get acquired with knowledge of SHE legal requirement, management system requirement, chemical, mechanical, fire, occupational health, industrial hygiene and electrical hazards.

- Identify SHE related statutory compliance requirement

## Occupational Health & Hygiene at Workplace 16 - 17 July 2026, National Safety Council, Hq., Navi Mumbai

### ABOUT THE COURSE

The work environment and its relation to worker's health were recognized as early as in the fourth century BC when Hippocrates noted lead toxicity amongst workers employed in mining industry. Since then, industrial hygiene is being acknowledged in prevention and control of occupational illnesses all over the world.

Industrial hygiene is a science of anticipating, recognizing, evaluating, and controlling workplace conditions in relation to worker's health and illness. Workplace monitoring and analytical methods are used to assess workers exposure to hazards and suggest suitable control measures.

Indian and international statutes and standards spell out discretely the industrial hygiene aspects i.e. Occupational Exposure Limits of airborne chemical contaminants, required levels of illumination and noise, removal of pollutants and heat by ventilation, workplace and environment monitoring and biological monitoring of worker etc. Implementation of these provisions is the minimum requirement for industries. However, there is a need to assess the hazardous physical

conditions and chemical pollutants in the workplace and plan accordingly for a healthy and hygienic atmosphere.

NSC has scheduled this 2-days training programme on "Occupational Health and Hygiene at Workplace", aimed at acquaintance of the participants with the industrial hygiene problems, identification of the areas for improvement and designing better workplace for a better health.

At the end of the programme participants will be able to:

- Possess better knowledge of workers occupational exposure to chemical, physical, ergonomic, and biological hazards, their environmental / biological monitoring and the control measures at the workplace.
