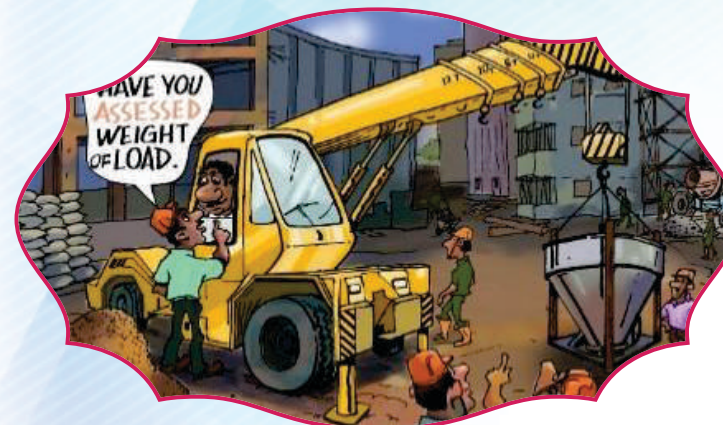

ABOUT THE COURSE

In factories, ports and construction sites, several operations and processes involve the use of lifting machinery, lifting tackles, chains, ropes, etc. for material handling. Improper selection, inadequate strength, patent defects and poor operating practices, etc., are some of the known causes for failure of the lifting equipment which can result in fatal or serious injuries and damage to equipment, material, or other facilities. To prevent such unwanted events, it is essential that users of these equipment's are familiar with the various safety requirements relating to their design, construction, testing, examination, maintenance, and operation. These equipment's are also required to be periodically examined and tested as prescribed under different statutes. This programme is designed to enhance knowledge and skills in safe lifting and rigging operations. The training focuses on both theoretical understanding and practical application of statutory requirements, safe work practices, and effective supervision of lifting and rigging activities at workplaces.

LEARNING OUTCOME

- After successful completion of the training, participants will be able to:
- Understand statutory requirements for lifting and rigging operations.
 - Inspect and test lifting equipment, tools, and tackles effectively.
 - Plan and analyze lifting jobs with emphasis on ground condition and load stability.
 - Select suitable lifting tools and tackles for specific jobs.
 - Apply safe slinging practices and understand lifting angles.
 - Identify blind zones and implement safe control measures.
 - Supervise lifting and rigging activities safely and efficiently.

COVERAGE

- The programme will cover the following areas:
- Statutory requirements regarding lifting & rigging.

- Inspection and testing of lifting equipment, tools, and tackles.
- Preparation of lifting plan
- Job analysis prior to lifting operations.
- Ground condition and load stability assessment.
- Safe selection of tools and tackles.
- Safe slinging practices and lifting angles.
- Hazard identification and control in blind zones.
- Practical hands-on rigging and lifting operations.

TRAINING METHODOLOGY:

This 2-day course will be conducted through a combination of classroom sessions and practical hands-on exercises which include Interactive classroom lectures and discussions, Case studies and real-life examples, Demonstrations of lifting and rigging practices., Practical hands-on exercises on safe rigging operations, Group activities and problem-solving sessions.

ABOUT THE COURSE

A Safety and Health audit is a management tool for systematic evaluation of how well the operation and maintenance procedures match with design intent and statutes. Already large tome of Health and Safety legislation continues to grow with the introduction of additional regulations and guidelines. Moreover, Governments also use a larger stick to punish non-compliance. Not only bigger fines are imposed on companies but their directors and senior management face imprisonment for neglect of duties. Also, the adverse public relations resulting from poor regulatory compliance can result in lost consumer goodwill, and it can hurt valuable brand names. Statutory Compliance Audits can be used as a useful tool in reviewing an organisation's health and safety procedures and legal compliance. Findings from the compliance audit identify gaps in an organisation's current policy and procedure or that they have been superseded by more recent legislation.

After completion of this course the participants will get acquired with knowledge of SHE legal requirement, management system requirement, chemical, mechanical, fire, occupational health, industrial hygiene and electrical hazards.
