ABOUT THE COURSE

In factories, ports and construction sites, several operations and processes involve the use of lifting machinery, lifting tackles, chains, ropes, etc. for material handling. Improper selection, inadequate strength, patent defects and poor operating practices, etc., are some of the known causes for failure of the lifting equipment which can result in fatal or serious injuries and damage to equipment, material, or other facilities. To prevent such unwanted events, it is essential that users of these equipment's are familiar with the various safety requirements relating to their design, construction, testing, examination, maintenance, and operation. These equipment's are also required to be periodically examined and tested as prescribed under different statutes.

These 3 days programme is designed to enhance knowledge and skills in safe lifting and rigging operations. The training focuses on both theoretical understanding and practical application of statutory requirements, safe work practices, and effective supervision of lifting and rigging activities at workplaces.

LEARNING OUTCOME

After successful completion of the training, participants will gain the skills and confidence to safely supervise and manage lifting and rigging activities at the workplace.

COVERAGE

The programme will cover the following areas:

- Statutory requirements regarding lifting & rigging

- Inspection and testing of lifting equipment, tools, and tackles
- Preparation of lifting plan
- Ground condition and load stability assessment
- Safe selection of tools and tackles
- Safe slinging practices and lifting angles
- blind zones
- Practical hands-on rigging and lifting operations

WHO SHALL ATTEND:

Supervisors and engineers involved in lifting and rigging operations, safety officers, maintenance and plant engineers handling lifting equipment, contractors and subcontractors engaged in rigging activity.

CERTIFICATE:

ABOUT THE COURSE

The Permit to Work (PTW) system is one of the most important administrative control measures for managing high-risk activities in industries such as manufacturing, construction, oil & gas, ports, power plants, engineering and infrastructure projects. Many serious accidents occur not because procedures do not exist, but because the Permit-to-Work system is poorly understood, inadequately implemented or treated as a routine paperwork exercise.

This intensive 2-day training programme is designed to strengthen both conceptual clarity and hands-on competency in implementing an effective PTW system. The course goes beyond theory and focuses on practical workplace applications, real case studies, documentation practices and common implementation challenges faced by industries.

LEARNING OUTCOME

This 2 days programme will enable participants to gain the skills and confidence to safely supervise and manage non routine / risk involved activities at the workplace.

- Statutory Provisions and Industry Best Practices
- Types of Permits (Hot Work, Cold Work, Confined Space Entry, Electrical Work, Excavation, Height Work)

ABOUT THE COURSE

Hazardous Waste is defined as any waste which by reason of any of its physical, chemical, reactive, toxic, flammable, explosive or corrosive characteristics causes danger or is likely to cause danger to health or environment, whether alone or when in contact with other wastes or substances. If hazardous waste not handled properly can have serious implications on environment and health of people. The Ministry of Environment and Forest (MoEF) has formulated Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 for effective management of hazardous waste. Original Rules were introduced in 1989 and have been amended no. of times to meet hazardous waste management requirements. It involves proper collection, safe transportation, adequate storage, environmentally sound treatment and disposal.

This 2-day NSCI training programme has been designed to deal with various aspects of hazardous waste.

LEARNING OUTCOME

On completion of this programme, the participant will be able to create awareness and promote self-compliance of statutory requirements under the hazardous waste rules.
