NSCI'S VIRTUAL CLASSROOM TRAINING PROGRAM ON

Safety in Storage, Handling and Transportation of Chemicals

13 February 2025 (Time: 01: 00 PM - 05: 00PM)

PERSPECTIVE: The sensitivity and risk factors involved in storage, handling and transporting chemicals requires specific precautions including meticulous packaging, specific handling and training and development for persons engaged. The carriers that carry hazardous goods, approximately two-thirds of them carry flammable petroleum products including Kerosene, Petrol, LPG, Naphtha etc. The movement of such substances is more prone to accident than the movement of other goods. When involved in a road accident, may cause disastrous consequences like fire, explosion, injuries, in addition to property loss and environmental pollution.

The Factories Act 1948, The Manufacture, Storage and import of Hazardous Chemicals (amendment) Rules 2000, The Central Motor Vehicle (Amendment) Act 2019 and other legal requirement provide guidelines to improve the overall safety condition in various industries, specially dealing with hazardous chemicals. Some of the accident in the past like Bhopal tragedy of 1984 was due to not following above provisions.

NSC has designed this program on Safety in Storage Handling and Transportation of Chemicals to create awareness on Safe storage, handling and transportation of chemicals.

OBJECTIVE: On completion of this program, the participant will be able to understand

- Legal provisions
- Safe practices for storage, handling and transportation of chemicals

TOPIC: This virtual classroom training program will cover following topics:

- Legal provisions related to Safe Storage, Handling and Transportation of Chemicals
- Safe Storage and Handling of Chemical
- Safe transportation of Chemicals



TRAINING METHODOLOGY: This program will be conducted in 4 hours video-based session.

WHO SHALL ATTEND: Senior/middle management personnel, safety officers, supervisors, departmental staff, contract workers who are involved in handling of chemicals.

FACULTY: Expert from the approved member of expert panel of National Safety Council.
