Eligibility Criteria

Any School* affiliated with State/ National/International/ Private National Boards.

* School -means any recognized school imparting elementary education and includes

- a school established, owned, or controlled by the appropriate Government or a local authority.
- an aided school receiving aid or grants to meet whole or part of its expenses from the appropriate Government or the local authority.
- a school belonging to specified category; and
- an unaided school not receiving any kind of aid or grants to meet its expenses from the appropriate Government or the local authority.

(as defined under section 2 (n) of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act 2009)

Award Year : Academic Year – 2026

Assessment Period : One Academic Year (2025) previous to the Awards Year - 2026

Categories : Schools are classified into two groups for fair and equitable assessment:

Group	Name	Description
Group A	State Board Schools	Schools affiliated with State Board approved curricula
Group B	National / International Board Schools	Schools affiliated with National, International, or Private National Boards (e.g., CBSE, CISCE/ICSE, IB, IGCSE and NIOS)

HOW TO APPLY

- The Application Form is available for free download on NSC website at <https://nsc.org.in>
- Read carefully the Rules & Regulations and Instructions for filling-up & submission of the application form.
- The Application Form Offline submission:
 - Send the filled-in Application Form (one hard copy and one soft copy in pen-drive) along with a payment in the form of Demand Draft towards a processing fee. If payment is made by Online/NEFT/ RTGS/ BANK transfer, provide its details at the space provided in the Application Form.
 - The filled-in Application Form can be sent by post/courier or hand delivery at National Safety Council, Plot No. 98-A, Sector-15, CBD Belapur, Navi Mumbai – 400 614.
- Last date for receiving the application in NSC is **30th September, 2026**.
- Mode of Payment

ABOUT NATIONAL SAFETY COUNCIL OF INDIA

The National Safety Council of India (NSCI) is an apex level organization in the field of Occupational Safety and Health in India. It was set up by the Ministry of Labour, Govt. of India on 4th March 1966 as an independent, not for profit and autonomous society.

VISION: Be a national leader for providing guidance and services to make workplaces safer, healthier, and environmentally friendly.

MISSION: Building capacity, developing material, methods, procedures and strengthening the national movement (including unorganized sector) on Safety, Health, and Environment to prevent and mitigate the loss of life, human suffering and economic losses.

- To fulfill its objective, NSC carries out various activities. These include organizing and conducting specialized training programmes/courses, conferences, seminars & workshops; conducting consultancy studies such as safety audits, hazard evaluation & risk assessment; designing and developing HSE promotional materials & publications; facilitating organizations in celebrating various campaigns e.g. National Safety Day/Week, Fire Service Week, World Environment Day, Road Safety Month and National Electrical Safety Week.
- To its credit, NSC has successfully organized many national and international conferences e.g. XIII World Congress (1993) and APOSHO Conferences (1995, 2016 & 2025) and implemented many prestigious projects. It also serves as a gateway to the state-of-art information on HSE aspects at the international level.
- NSCI Safety Shield: A scheme to recognize and reward excellence in OSH management systems. Only organizations that have won 5 Golden Star ratings are eligible to apply.
- NSAT: The National Safety Aptitude Test helps organizations in selecting and recruiting safety officers. It also enables evaluation of employees' OHS competence and measures the efficacy of OHS initiatives.
- As one of the NSC's activities and initiatives, it instituted an annual NSCI Safety Awards scheme for the Manufacturing Sector in the year 1998 and later extended it to the Construction Sector in 2005, MSME Sector in 2009, Service Sector in 2020 and Women in Safety - Excellence Awards in 2026.
- NSCI Safety Awards are highly coveted Awards at the national level for recognizing exemplary performance and effective safety and health management systems and procedures established by Organizations in Manufacturing, Construction, MSME and Service sectors.
