Sub: 55<sup>th</sup> National Safety Day/National Safety Month Campaign - Commencing from 4<sup>th</sup> March 2026

The **National Safety Day (NSD)** Campaign, spearheaded by the National Safety Council of India (NSC) to commemorate its Foundation Day on 4<sup>th</sup> March, is entering its **55<sup>th</sup>** year in 2026. Over the years, the campaign has evolved into a nationwide movement for promoting Occupational Safety and Health (OSH) and is widely celebrated by industries, trade unions, government departments, regulatory agencies, NGOs, and institutions, with active support of the Central and State Governments and the general public.

To further strengthen safety culture amongst the public and address emerging challenges across both organised and unorganised sectors, the **theme for 55<sup>th</sup> National Safety Day/National Safety Month** has been finalised as:

The theme highlights the importance of active participation, continuous learning, and empowerment of people at all levels to build a proactive safety culture and prevent accidents. Organisations henceforth will have enough opportunities to conduct various activities in a focussed manner around the theme
