SUPERVISORY TRAINING PROGRAMME FOR COMPETENT SUPERVISION UNDER SECTION 41-C(b) OF THE FACTORIES ACT, 1948

To build competency of the supervisory personnel working in the hazardous process industries, as per Section 41-C(b) of the Factories Act, 1948, the National Safety Council has decided to conduct a four week *Specialized Certificate Course for Supervisors working in Hazardous Process Industries*. The National Safety Council has received the approval of Directorate General, Factory Advice Service and Labour Institutes (DGFASLI), Ministry of Labour & Employment, Government of India, for this purpose. The Qualification & Experience required for the course is as below:

- i) Degree in Chemistry or Diploma in any branch of Engineering or Technology with 5 years experience in process operation and maintenance in industry involving hazardous substances, or
- ii) Masters Degree in Chemistry or a Degree in any branch of Engineering or Technology with 2 years experience in process operation and maintenance in industry involving hazardous substances

The course will be conducted as:

- A) National Level Programme where organizations can nominate participants.

 Dates, course fees, venue, etc. about the programme will be announced in due course.
- B) In-plant Programme, upon request from the industries. The offer for conducting such programme at company premises will be sent on request.

Certificates to successful candidates will be issued by the DGFASLI.
