All OHS professionals, corporate leaders, researchers including experts, academicians, enforcement officials, policy makers, etc. are invited to contribute their articles/ research papers on Safety, Health & Environment.

The guidelines for submitting articles are as follows:

- Articles should cover new/emerging developments in the OSH field and their impact on organizations, institutes and society at large.
- Articles could also be based on the success story(s) on implemented in organization in industries
 or research undertaken in specific area of Safety, Health & Environment.
- The article should be of 3000 words, in English in addition to graphics and/or pictures/photos (HD resolution).
- The font should be Times New Roman (size 11). The margins should be normal (1" all sides).
- The use of references and/or endnotes is strongly encouraged, as they increase the relevance and significance of an article. Include all relevant sources of information (e.g., author, publisher, title of book or article, magazine name, date/year of publication, country of publication). The authors are advised to obtain necessary permission for quoted or borrowed material prior to sending the articles.

Selection of articles for publishing:

- The editorial committee will select the most promising articles from those submitted for publication.
- The author of the selected article would be given an honorarium of Rs. 3000/- towards their contribution.
- Based on the theme of the issue, relevant articles would be included and after printing its copy would be sent to the author. The forthcoming themes of the issues are "Process Safety", "Safety Training & Education", "Mines Safety", "Construction Safety", "Road Safety", "Material Handling", "Ergonomics", "Waste Management", "Disaster Management", etc.
