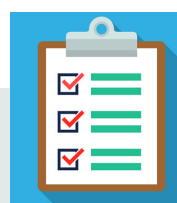
In this pursuit, NSC describes a tool for qualitative auditing of the efficiency, effectiveness and reliability of occupational health and hygiene service provision within an organization.

- Identify potential health hazards w.r.to Physical, Chemical, Biological, Ergonomic and hazards not covered by the existing systems, procedures & practices.
- Recommend improvements for better effectiveness of the existing OHH system w.r.to Statutory requirements and best practices.
- Study compliance with critical statutory provisions, monitoring data and relevant codes of practices and recommend actions to be taken, wherever there is non-compliance.

- Occupational health and hygiene audit is an important tool used to identify and evaluate the impact of workplace hazards that may affect the health of the workers and to assess control measures provided to reduce the hazards.
