PERSPECTIVE: Hazardous Waste(HW) is defined as any waste which by reason of any of its physical, chemical, reactive, toxic, flammable, explosive or corrosive characteristics causes danger or is likely to cause danger to health or environment, whether alone or when in contact with other wastes or substances. Electronic waste or e-waste describes discarded electrical or electronic devices. Used electronics which are destined for refurbishment, reuse, resale, salvage recycling through material recovery, or disposal are also considered e-waste. Hazardous Waste and E-waste if not handled properly can have serious implication on environment and health of people. Currently it is estimated that about 74.6 lakh tons of hazardous waste and 5.2 MT of E- Waste generated every year in India. The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change has formulated The Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 and The E-Waste Management Rules, 2016 for effective management of HW and E- Waste respectively. These rules have been amended a no. of times to remain up-to-date with latest changes and technologies. This training programme has been designed to deal with various aspects of Hazardous waste and E- waste management.

OBJECTIVE: This program will create awareness and promote self-compliance of the statutory requirements under the Rules and provide platform for sharing of experiences.

TOPIC: This 4 hours video based virtual class room training program will cover following topics:

- Application of HW Rules 2016 and E- waste Rules 2016
- Procedure for Management of Hazardous and Other Wastes and E- Wastes
- Responsibilities of the occupier, State Government
- Storage and Disposal of hazardous and other wastes and E- Waste.

TRAINING METHODOLOGY: This program will be conducted in 4 hours video based session.
