# BIS New Standard on Hazard Identification and Risk Assessment (HIRA)

In addition to IS 15656: 2006 Hazard Identification and risk analysis — Code of practice, BIS released standard on "IS 18347 : 2023 Hazard Identification and Risk Assessment (Other than Chemical Industries) — Code of Practice" to carry out Risk assessment by a combination of hazard analysis, consequence analysis, and probability calculations. In this standard, a 3 by 3 risk level estimator has been recommended to estimate risk level and a subsequent simple action plan relating to risk level has been described.

All employers have a legal duty/obligation to assess the risks of their work activities. The risk assessment procedure is useful for situations where the hazards pose a significant threat, and it is uncertain whether the existing or planned controls are adequate in principle or practice; and for organizations seeking continual improvement in their occupational health and safety (OH&S) management systems in addition to meeting legal requirements.

This new standard as "IS 18347: 2023 Hazard Identification and

Risk Assessment (Other than Chemical Industries) — Code of

Practice" would help to minimize accident occurrence in industrial operation/activity by identifying hazards and estimating their risk level and subsequent action plan on control measures.



# The Plastic Waste Management (Second Amendment) Rules, 2023



Recently, the Ministry of Environment, Forest, and Climate Change, Government of India has amended the Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 vide notification dated 30.10.2023, and these amendments bring certain understanding into the management of plastic waste, particularly related to Extended Producer Responsibility ("EPR"), Compostable Plastic and Biodegradable Plastic technologies. The major emphasis has been given on use of information technology tools for online reporting and capturing data at various stages of waste management of state and local authority level; provide for online electronic trading platform. The amendments are significant for

- Raw Material/Masterbatch manufacturers
- Sellers/Distributors of plastic products and technologies
- Plastic manufacturers
- Packaging companies
- Packaging-intensive companies
