NSCI'S VIRTUAL CLASSROOM TRAINING PROGRAM ON

"Chemical Supervisor in Hazardous Industries"

15-16 February, 2024 (Time: 01:00 - 05:00 PM)

PERSPECTIVE: Chemicals are widely used throughout society, with both positive and negative effects on health, well-being, socio-economic aspects, and the environment. Workers around the world are exposed to hazardous substances, including pollutants, dusts, vapours, and fumes almost all workplace areas. These workers lose their lives each year due to exposure to hazardous chemicals. For those who do not lose their lives, they may face non-fatal injuries and diseases resulting in disability, debilitating chronic disease and other health impacts. All these deaths, injuries and illnesses are entirely preventable. Section 41C(b) of the Factories Act 1948 as amended in 1987 has imposed specific responsibilities on the occupier, regarding hazardous processes, which states that every occupier of the factory involving any hazardous process shall appoint persons who possess qualification & experience in handling hazardous substances and are competent to supervise such activities within the factory.

In line with this, NSC has designed this 2-day Virtual training program on "Chemical Supervisor in Hazardous Industries" to create awareness on handling of hazardous substances.

OBJECTIVE: On completion of this program, the participant will become aware of hazards and legal requirements for handling, storage and transportation of hazardous chemicals

TOPIC: This virtual classroom training program will cover following topics:

- Overview of legal requirement for handling of chemicals.
- Basic principles of Accident Prevention.
- Hazard identification and risk assessment.
- Fire and Explosion Hazards.
- Industrial Hygiene and Control Methods.
- Chemical Emergency Management.
- Motivation for Safety.
- Safety Audit Chemical.

PROGRAM FEE Rs. 5000/plus 18% GST (Total Rs. 5900/-) per participant.

TRAINING METHODOLOGY: This program will be conducted in 8 hours video-based session.

WHO SHALL ATTEND: Senior/middle management personnel, supervisors, departmental staff, contract workers who are involved in handling of chemicals.

FACULTY: Expert from the approved member of expert panel of National Safety Council.
