PERSPECTIVE: A number of legislations are enforced by the Central and State Governments to ensure safety, health and welfare of employees, safeguard the public at large and preserve the environment. In addition, certain legislations prescribe technical standards and requirements dangerous machines/equipments and hazardous substances must conform to. Recent changes made in safety legislations have placed increased responsibility on managements, particularly of those using hazardous processes and chemicals. The Petroleum Rules, 2002 and Explosives Rules, 2010. The 2001, The Central Electricity Authority Regulations 2010, The Gas Cylinder Rules, 2016, The Static, Mobile Pressure 2016 and Rules. The Hazardous Waste Vessels Handling (Management, and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 have been amended in the recent past. Statutes Occupational Safety and Health prescribe provisions which require to be implemented with correct spirit. The training program is being organised to discuss the

different provision of the statutes with latest amendments.

OBJECTIVE: On completion of this the program, participant will be able to to acquaint themselves principles behind the law, refresh and update their knowledge about the provisions of the Acts and their Rules with recent amendments.

WHO SHALL ATTEND: The programme is best suited for Safety Officers, Personnel/Legal Officers, Labour Officers and other Officers responsible for compliance with safety and health provisions and also Trade Union Representatives and Officials from Enforcement Agencies.

TRAINING METHODOLOGY

: This program will be conducted in 4 hours video based session.

- The Building and other Construction Workers (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) Act 1996 and Rules enacted in 1998
- The Manufacture, Storage and Import of Hazardous Chemicals Rules, 1989 with amendments
- The Gas Cylinders Rules , 2016; The Static & Mobile Pressure Vessels (Unfired) Rules 2016
- The Hazardous Waste (Management, Handling and Transboundry Movement) Rules, 2016
- The Bio-medical Waste Management Rules, 2016
- The Petroleum Act, 1934 and Rules 2002 (Amended)
- The Environment Protection Act, The Air (Prevention & Control Of Pollution) Act 1981 and The Water (Prevention & Control Of Pollution) Act 1974
- The Indian Boiler Act 1923 and The Indian Boiler Regulation 1950
